Head Coach Steve Johnson

Coach Johnson enters his 7th season at the helm for the Grizzlies. Johnson was the 2005 and 2007 Jayhawk West Conference Coach of the Year. In 2006 he was named the Central District Coach of the year by the ABCA, after leading Butler to their 1st appearance in the JUCO World Series since 1994. Johnson played at Barton County and at the University of Alabama-Birmingham before spending five years in the St. Louis Cardinals organization as a minor league pitcher. Johnson has been instrumental in the development of several major league players and moving numerous players to the NCAA level.

Asst. Coach B.J. McVay

Coach McVay enters his 6th year with the Grizzlies. McVay is the hitting coach at Butler along with coaching outfielders and being the recruiting coordinator. McVay has coached 15 All-Conference players and two All-Region players. Previously McVay coached two years at Southeastern Oklahoma State University and one year at Barton County Community College. McVay played at Barton County and Southeastern Oklahoma State University. While at Southeastern he was a member of the 2000 National Championship team.

Asst. Coach Ty Reese

Coach Reese enters his 2nd season with the Grizzlies. Coach Reese works mainly with the pitchers. Coach Reese is also the pitching coach for the El Dorado Broncos. The Broncos are summers colligate team. The El Dorado Broncos won the 2009 NBC World Series. Coach Reese played at Butler Community College and Emporia State University. He was a member of the 2005 Butler Grizzlies Conference Championship team. Member of the 2006 and 2008 MIAA Conference titles at Emporia State University.
